Please Note

PFD OR LIFE-JACKET is required as approved by the Canadian coast guard or equivalent & fits your child

Life jackets must be brought to camp. Wilvaken has a limited supply, so we ask parents to purchase one that fits their child. If campers arrive without one, they will be assigned a life jacket that will be used for the duration of their stay.

What not to bring to camp?

Cellphone, tablet, electronic games – Our technology policy is there to disconnect! We ask parents to support this effort. Speak with your children about this before they arrive at camp! If not left with the parents, all technology will be collected and kept safe until departure day.

Aerosol cans - For bug spray, sunscreen, etc. Aerosol cans are bad for the environment.

Candy & other snacks - This policy is in place to avoid animals and insects entering cabins. As well, we must consider camper allergies. All food will be collected and stored upon arrival.

Cash, jewelry, items of value – if necessary, we will keep these items in our office until departure day.

The right luggage – We recommend to use a duffel bag or large hockey-style bag as they can be folded when empty. Cabins do not have space for hard suitcases or bins.

Wilvaken is not responsible for lost or damaged personal articles, nor for any valuables which are not left in safekeeping at our office.

Some suggestions:

- Every camper has a large drawer to store all their items. There are hooks in the cabin for towels, coats, etc.
- Pack with your campers! This way, they know everything that they've brought with them to camp!
- Keep a copy of the list and write down any specifics of what was packed. Send it to camp with them
- Explain what to do with dirty laundry: teach them how to use their laundry bag
- Label your luggage they all look similar, and you will not be there to help pack at departure!
- We play outside, even in the rain. Clothing can get dirty, stained, torn, or sometimes forgotten. Please avoid packing items that are extra special for your kids
- In case of an accident, or no more clean clothing, we will offer laundry service with a fee.
